If your school is seeking a scholarship to help attend the overnight program, be sure to turn the form over and complete the back.

We will do our best to accommodate each school. Given the limited number of weeks in the spring and the number of schools that ask for those weeks, however, we encourage you to consider the fall and winter months. Many teachers already have seen how coming earlier in the year allows for a fuller integration of the IslandWood experience into classroom curricula and how community-building skills learned at IslandWood carry over into the remainder of the school year.

The **deadline for completed applications is February 1, 2012.** We still accept applications after this date if we have spaces remaining, but our scholarship endowment is allocated among the schools that have applied by Feb. 1.

**There is no deposit required to apply or obligation to commit during the application period.** When our schedule is drafted in March, we will notify you of your proposed week and of any scholarship money your school may have been awarded. If your proposed week is acceptable, we will ask you to commit by returning a signed Confirmation Agreement and deposit at that time.

## 2012-13 Tuition for the School Overnight Program

The price includes all lodging, meals, curriculum, instructors and evening programs. Pre- and post-classroom visits to your school and a professional development session for your teachers while they are at IslandWood are also included in the price.

One teacher per twenty-five students attending is free. One chaperone per field group (average field group size = 10 students) is charged the chaperone price.

IslandWood is committed to serving students of all cultures and economic backgrounds. We have scholarships available to help schools that meet our scholarship criteria.

Your school is financially responsible for all of the students (less 10% attrition due to illness, moving, etc.) that you confirm on your Confirmation Agreement. Your final payment is due 30 days after the last day of your visit, unless other arrangements have been made.
